



#### "CHIQUITA!" Trio for Winds - Grade 6

This fanfare is regal & bombastic in equal measure. Competition piece for the 2008 Dallas Wind Symphony Fanfare Competition.






## "Great is Thy Faithfulness" Arranged for Singer + Orchestra

Rollicking themes, tuneful melodies, and a flurry of eight-note passages (in cut-time), Molly On The Shore is a wonderful work by the Australian composer Percy Grainger. Today, it is recognized as a staple in band literature, and arguably the most characteristic of all his works. Here is a thrillingly furnished arrangement for clarinet quartet. Clarinet often cited as the main draw of his symphonic version, clarinetists will want to own this distinctive version of Grainger's masterwork, sure to charm audiences again and again. \*NOW with with E-flat Clarinet Substitution!\*



#### "Molly On The Shore: REDUX" For Saxophone Quartet - Grade 5

After some initial success with a <u>Clarinet Quartet</u> version of this Grainger arrangement (a viral rendition of which is currently ranked #1 on YouTube), came a request from the Resalta Saxophone Quartet to rearrange "Molly On the Shore" for saxes, a project which yielded some rather striking results. In this arrangement, I have completely reimagined the work from the ground up, with alterations to its key, articulation schema, and general aesthetic. The resultant arrangement has proved quite a popular one, and now I'd like to share it with you!

## "7 Motors To Power Your Way" For Unaccompanied Tuba - Grade 6

Based on the notion that the "engines" of life are unique, varied, and powerful, this work was commissioned by a consortium of players, led by Dr. Jerome Stover, on behalf of Professor Mouthpiece. "7 Motors" is a charismatic and demanding multi-movement work, whose solo setting allows a space for both lyrical expressiveness, as well as melodic propulsion. <u>Listen | View Score | More Info</u>

#### "The Music Box" Fantasy For Orchestra Grade 6

This work takes its cue from a TED Talk Series, in which Movie Director JJ Abrams (Cloverfield, Star Trek) referred to the philosophy of the "Mystery Box," one in which suspense is derived from that which is not seen, nor revealed. Conceptually, this piece is meant to sound and behave like a music box (the old fashioned kind; one with a giant hand crank on the side!). Indeed, one must approach this work with the utmost care. After all, you never know where "The Music Box" may begin, nor where it will end... A finalist in the 2023 EarShot Initiative with the Dallas Symphony, "The Music Box" has also received recent international recognition with a number of professional arts organizations, including the Sphinx Organization & New York Philharmonic Orchestra.


